**Conditions of sale:** Full remittance should accompany all orders. **Cash, check or money order only.** No credit cards at this time.

**Shipping and handling:** East of the Rockies add 20% to your total. West of there add 25%. **Minimum shipping charge is \$6.00.** This applies to ALL orders including seeds.

**Substitutions:** For any unavailable items, please check the appropriate box at the bottom of the order form. Unless otherwise directed by you, we will make substitutions in size only at no extra charge to you. Listing substitutions often helps you get your money's worth out of the shipping. **Shipping dates:** Most plants are grown in containers and so can be shipped at almost any time except during extremes of heat or cold. Plant orders will normally be shipped within 1 week of our receiving the order unless otherwise requested by you under "preferred ship date".
